

OUR CAUSE

In the last year, Literacy Volunteers welcomed over 440 students, more than twice as many as just two years ago. The majority of our current students are immigrants, which is why the Board of Directors of LVWA has chosen Dia De Los Muertos as the theme of its annual gala, to reflect the international aspect of our work.

Since 1985, Literacy Volunteers Winchester Area has helped adults reach their goals through education. LVWA's first students met with their volunteer tutors in Handley Library. Most students worked on learning to read better. In the intervening time, LVWA has added computer, English language, and citizenship instruction, as well as an immigration law practice.

WHY SUPPORT LITERACY VOLUNTEERS

Literacy Volunteers exists solely to serve individuals who struggle to support themselves. Our motivated learners understand that education is the key to a more self-reliant, brighter future. Almost all of our students are focused on improving skills that employers most value: English fluency, computer competency, numeracy, and basic literacy.

Investment in adult education pays off. A recent longitudinal study following high school dropouts over ten years showed that participants in adult education programs—like those offered by LVWA—had mean income gains of 53 percent. Non-participants' wages actually declined.



ABOUT DIA DE LOS MUERTOS/DAY OF THE DEAD

A celebration of life and death, the Day of the Dead brings together families and friends in honoring those that have left them. This tradition is celebrated in Mexico, and throughout much of Central and South America. While there are some commonalities, each community, each family, has a unique way to celebrate it.

On the Day of the Dead, it is believed that the border between the spirit world and the real-world dissolves. During this brief period, the souls of the dead wake up and return to the living world to feast, drink, dance and play music with their loved ones. The living family members treat the deceased as honored guests in their celebrations and leave the deceased's favorite foods and other offerings at gravesites or on the ofrendas built in their homes.

Traditional food cooked during these days includes tamales, chiles rellenos, moles, and most important, pan de muerto (bread of the dead, translated literally). Food is so central in Day of the Dead celebrations because it is a feast that brings together the living with the dead.


